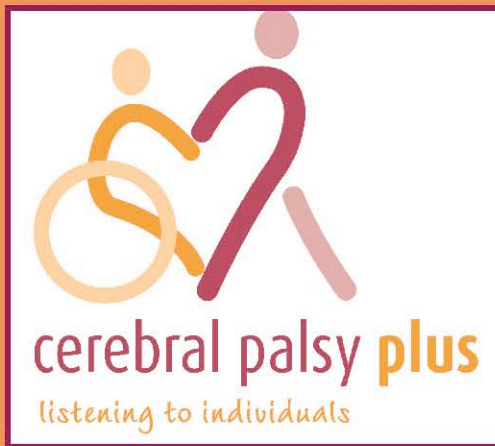


Who are Cerebral palsy plus?

What do we offer?

Fieldworker

At **Cerebral palsy plus** we recognise that families need specialist support and advice from the early days of diagnosis, through school, teenage years and into adulthood. Our Fieldworker offers emotional, social and psychological help and support

Someone who understands

Our Fieldworker is a qualified counsellor. She can offer every member of the family, including siblings and grandparents, the support they need. She can help with practical necessities; for example applying for benefits and grants. She can work around families and make home visits (if that's what is preferred) at a convenient time.

Does our help cost families anything?

No. Our Fieldworker is funded by the charity.

Children's Activities

Cerebral palsy plus offers activities for children with cerebral palsy and their families. These include family trips to adventure parks and swimming sessions. Our range of activities is expanding all the time. Please see our website or contact the office for up to date details.

Information Service

We provide free, impartial information and guidance on a full range of issues including - education, holidays and therapies. All calls are dealt with in confidence by experienced and helpful staff. If you need advice or information on any disability related issue, do please contact us by phone, post or email.

Grants

We give financial assistance to individuals, and occasionally, groups. All applications need to be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a health professional or social worker. Please contact the office for an application form.

Holiday Apartment

Cerebral palsy plus has an apartment on the Algarve, Portugal. The apartment is available to us for two separate weeks of the year, usually in the Autumn and Spring. The apartment sleeps six and is located on a five star complex. We offer the apartment, free of charge, to people with cerebral palsy and their families. You only have to get there!

For Adults

We fund an evening club for adults with cerebral palsy. The club meets on Tuesdays, at various locations around Bristol. Please contact the office for details.
